Did you know...

- Project Hope for the Homeless, Lake County's only homeless shelter, has been serving the homeless men, women and families of Lake County for 15 years.
- There are enough beds for 35 people to receive shelter, care and guidance each night at Project Hope. They serve about 30 people each night, with more than 60% of clients moving to a higher quality of living.
- Almost 65% of people coming to Project Hope are suffering from drug addictions, mental health disorders, or both.

To join the Chain of Hope, each business will set a goal to reach. As donations come in, that business will be able to add links to their chain. Once they reach their goal and drop off their links and money, they'll receive a special certificate recognizing their contribution, and will take their last link to the next business on the list.
