Adding up your spare pennies, nickels, quarters and dimes equals a huge change for the homeless.

Penny wars: It makes cents!

The objective:

Win the “war” against homelessness for your team by gaining points. Classrooms, homerooms, or grade levels can compete against each other for victory.

Add: Your copper (pennies) to your team's bucket. Toss your silver (nickels, dimes, quarters) and dollar bills into the opposing team's bucket.

Divide: At the end of the penny wars, divide your teams bucket into copper (pennies), and everything else (silver and dollar bills).

Subtract: The silver and dollars from the pennies. All of the copper in your bucket counts for positive points. All of the silver and dollar bills reduce the number of points. For example: your team has 150 pennies, which equals 150 points. If you have one dime, that lowers your score to 140. A nickel lowers your score by 5 points, a quarter by 25 points and a dollar bill by 100 points.

Multiply: Your end result. Will a parent or relative match your donation?
