

Project Hope for the Homeless, the only emergency homeless shelter in Lake County, serves up to 35 men, women and children each night, with guests coming from northeastern Ohio, surrounding counties, and out of state.

More than 300 people each year come to Project Hope broken, battling addictions and illnesses, and looking for a better life.

They find a shelter, that not only meets their basic needs, providing beds, meals and hygiene, but also meets them where they are spiritually and emotionally. Caring volunteers spend time with guests each evening over dinner, and supportive, experienced staff members help guests work to getting out of homelessness.

About 50% of guests transition to a higher quality of life, and more than 100 aftercare participants get help to maintain their new life.
